Dear Sir/ Madame,

My name is Mihaela Moagher and I write you because I want to apply for the scholarship named "Ludvigs Ekis". I read about it on the site of The Romanian Association For Baltic and Nordic Studies and I think I meet the conditions to participate to this competition.

In June 2011 I was accepted for a master programme at University of Tartu, Estonia. The name of the master programme is Estonian and Finno-Ugric Linguistics. I was one of the five persons who obtain the maximum score and as a consequence one of the fifteen persons for which the Estonian state is paying the studies.

Regarding my previous studies, I graduated History as a bachelor at Valahia University of Targoviste. My graduating paper "*The collapse of democracy in interwar period in Romania and Estonia: a comparative perspective*" represents a novelty in the academic research because no one before approached from a comparative perspective the collapse of interwar democracies in these two countries. Also in my third year as a bachelor I went for a semester as an exchange student at University of Tartu where I studied the intensive course of Estonian language and the course named *The history of the Baltic Sea Region*. From Tartu University, Department of Languages, I received a language certificate which attest my level of A2 regarding the knowledge of Estonian language. In the same time it must be said also the fact that this month I received an A to an Estonian grammar test which counts 20% from the final mark.

My interest for the Baltic and Nordic studies is also proven by the fact that I am a member of The Romanian Association For Baltic and Nordic Studies since January 2011 and by the fact that I worked as a volunteer at the organization of the first two

international conferences concerning Baltic and Nordic Studies, which took place in 2010, respectively 2011.

By receiving "Ludvigs Ekis" scholarship I will be able to continue my master studies, which I think are very important not only for myself but also for the Romanian academic research. By completing my master at Tartu University I will become the first Romanian specialist in Estonian language fact that could help the Romanian historical research concerning Estonian, Baltic and Nordic areas. It would not be an obstacle anymore to go to the archive and do research. Also a specialist in Estonian language could help to strengthen the cultural relations between Romania and Estonia.

After I finish my studies I want to continue my comparative research about the Estonian and Romanian interwar period and also I would like to translate Estonian literature and to create the the first Romanian-Estonian dictionary. For all the things presented above I think I deserve this scholarship.
